School Age Groups: 6-10, 11-15, 16-18

Rules

One poem per person

The theme is LM1 related. This can range from life on Earth to space exploration.

Any length is allowed.

Video entries are allowed as well as text, which will be uploaded and published online.

Deadline: 23:59 GMT, 30th September 2016

Prizes

Prizes will include allocated data storage for the Lunar Mission One Memory boxes, allowing them to put their personal art and information to be stored under the lunar surface for a very long time!

1st place = \$100 worth of data storage

2nd place = \$50 worth of data storage

3rd place = \$25 worth of data storage

Judging and Entries according to Chapter

1. The schools who have no chapter

a) Each school (2 persons) selects the best 3 poems for each age range (3 best poems for 6/10 years old; 3 best for the 11/15; and 3 for 16/18).

NB. *Any non-English poem that is selected must be translated into English by the school!*

b) Each school sends the selected poems to **pilot@lunarmissionone.com** with the:

Name of the school and country,
ID number of the school,
Name of the student,
Age of the student

2. The schools who have a chapter

a) Each school (2 persons) selects the 3 best poems for each age range (3 best poems for 6/10 years old; 3 best for the 11/15; and 3 for 16/18).

b) Each school sends all the selected poems to the **chapter of its own country** with the:

Name of the school and country,
ID number of the school,
Name of the student,
Age of the student

c) Each chapter with another person selects the 3 best poems for each range of age in the country.

NB. *Any non-English poem that is selected must be translated into English by the chapter!*
